






















Terms & Conditions

- The scholarship is offered strictly to registered students of Westlake International School upon enrolment, based on actual IGCSE, GCE, O Level, UEC or SPM results. It is mandatory that the recipient completes the entire duration of the course.
- Students who are admitted based on trial or forecast results would have to pay full fees upon enrolment.
 Once actual results are available, they are to submit their results slips within 2 weeks. Upon successful scholarship application, Finance Department would do the necessary adjustment or refund of fees.
- Disbursement of scholarship will be distributed in equal amount between the remaining terms of the programme. Full scholars need not make further term fee payments upon securing the scholarship.
- The scholar must maintain at least 60% of average score in their examination for each term.
- For students who are eligible for several forms of discount by Westlake International School (eg: staff discount, sibling discount, others), Governors A Level Scholarship awarded will be applicable on the net balance of the term fee payable after the deduction of the relevant discount.
